People will get modern health treatment under one roof.</p> <p>The opening of Medical college will give 150 trained & educated Medical Professionals to the society every year, who will contribute in serving the public at large.</p> <p>Thus opening up of a Medical College and Hospital in Indore would not only bridge the huge gap but will definitely contribute on its part for the service of needy patients of Indore in particular and the state at large.</p>

The **Shri Astha Foundation Society, Indore** has applied for establishment of a new Medical College at Indore. On carefull consideration of the proposal, the Government of Madhya Pradesh has decided to issue an essentiality certificate to the applicant for the establishment of **LNCT Medical College & Sevakunj Hospital, Indoire** with 150 seats.

It is certified that :-

- a. The applicant owns and manages a 330 beded hospital which was established in Indore.
- b. It is desirable to establish a Medical College in the public interest.
"Establishment of Medical College, Gram Kanadia, Sewakunj Hospital and Research Centre, Kanadia Rd. Residency Area, Indore. M.P. by Shri Astha Foundation Society, Indore is feasible".
- c. Adequate clinical material as per Medical Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Medical College as per MCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.


The following shall be added in terms of Notification dated 31-01-2017 published in the Gazette of India :-

- (e) The (Name of applicant Shri Astha Foundation Society, Indore) own and possesses 22.421 Acres of land in Gram Kanadia, Sewakunj Hospital and Research Centre, Kanadia Rd. Residency Area, Indore. M.P. on which non agricultural use of land is permitted and a Medical College/Hospital can be established on it.
- (f) The building plan of the Hospital and Medical College has been approved by the competent authority, namely Joint Director, Nagar and gram nivesh, distt. Office, Indore designated by the State Government for such purposes (Copy of the approval is enclosed)

(g) The Hospital and Medical College have been granted Completion Certificate/ Building Use Certificate by the competent authority namely, Joint Director, Nagar and gram nivesh, distt. Office, Indore designated by the State Government for such purpose on 26-06-2007 (Copy of the Certificate is enclosed)

Conditions (e),(f) and (g) are applicable only for non-governmental applicants.


